1. Which type of soda comes in a blue can: root beer or Pepsi?

Answer: Pepsi. Pepsi-Cola merged with Frito-Lay in 1965. They have products available in over 200 countries.

2. Which item is used to put out fires: fire alarms or fire extinguishers?

Answer: Fire extinguishers. Most fires in the home start in the kitchen or bedroom.

3. What do you add to balloons to make them float in the air: water or helium?

Answer: Helium. Helium is a gas that is lighter than air. Therefore, when a balloon is filled with helium, it will defy Earth's gravity and propel the balloon upward.
