

### Horse Card Game

In this card game of chance, each ace represents a racehorse.

**Number of players:** 4

**Object of the game:** Win if your ace card (or “horse”) crosses the finish line first.

**You will need:** A standard deck of cards with the jokers removed

**The race:**

1. The four players sit toward one end of the table.
2. Remove the aces from the deck and deal each player an ace faceup.
3. Shuffle the remaining cards well.
4. Deal six cards facedown vertically to the side of the aces to create the “racetrack,” [as shown](#).
5. The remaining cards are kept in a stack facedown.
6. The dealer or a player turns the first card on the stack so it’s faceup.
7. The player whose ace is in the same suit as the card that is turned over moves their ace one space, or the length of one of the side cards. The faceup card is moved aside or put on the bottom of the deck.
8. The next card from the deck is turned faceup, and again, the ace with the matching suit moves forward one space.
9. The first ace to move 7 times, or cross the “finish line” of cards, wins the horse race.
