(Questions with Answers)

1. Which is a popular boardwalk amusement ride: Skee-Ball or Ferris wheel?

Answer: Ferris wheel. The Ferris wheel was created by George Washington Gale Ferris Jr. for the World's Columbian Exposition of 1893 and was meant to rival the Eiffel Tower, which was the sensation of the 1889 World Exposition.

2. On which continent is the Great Wall located: Australia or Asia?

Answer: Asia. Construction of the Great Wall of China began more than 2,000 years ago, in the seventh century BC, and continued for hundreds of years. The wall was built to protect China from invaders.

3. Which type of truck has a spinning barrel on it: a mail truck or a cement truck?

Answer: A cement truck. A standard cement truck stands between 11 and 13.5 feet tall and is able to carry between eight to 14 yards of cement.

4. Finish the line to the song lyric: "I found my thrill on Blueberry _____": Mountain or Hill?

Answer: Hill. The song "Blueberry Hill" was written in 1940 by three songwriters. Fats Domino turned "Blueberry Hill" into a hit 16 years after it was written.

5. Which color is found on the Italian flag: orange or green?

Answer: Green. The green, white, and red flag was first introduced in 1796. The colors were based on the uniforms of the urban militia in Milan.

6. Which actor starred in the movie *To Catch a Thief*: Humphrey Bogart or Cary Grant?

Answer: Cary Grant. Grant's original name was Archie Leach. His name was legally changed in 1941.

7. Which is a brand of household appliances: Ford or Hoover?

Answer: Hoover. The Hoover vacuum was invented in 1907. Although their vacuums have gone through many changes since then, Hoover remains a popular brand today.

8. Which type of fluid is found in a car engine: windshield-washing fluid or motor oil?

Answer: Motor oil. The Shell Company made the first synthetic motor oil out of natural gas in the 1970s.

9. Which professional is responsible for managing money: receptionist or accountant?

Answer: Accountant. **Fun fact:** An accountant invented bubble gum in 1928.

10. Which vegetable is grown in the ground: grapes or carrots?

Answer: Carrots. Carrots are a great source of hydration. They are over 80 percent water.

11. Which instrument was played by Louis Armstrong: flute or trumpet?

Answer: Trumpet. The trumpet is capable of playing the highest note in the brass family.

12. Which insect makes honey: spiders or bees?

Answer: Bees. Honeybee hives always have a queen, workers, and drones. The worker bees are female but do not breed. Drones are male bees.

13. Which is a type of cheese: margarine or mozzarella?

Answer: Mozzarella. Mozzarella is considered a curd cheese and the most popular of the Italian soft cheeses.
