(Questions with Answers)

1. Which is a type of pickle: English or dill?

Answer: Dill. Cleopatra attributed her health and beauty to her love of pickles. Pickles have vitamins and minerals in them, including vitamin K, vitamin C, calcium, and potassium.

2. Which person is a famous artist: Roy Rogers or Claude Monet?

Answer: Claude Monet. Claude Monet is said to have hired gardeners to dust his pond prior to him painting it.

3. What is placed on a horse's back for a person to ride: horseshoe or saddle?

Answer: Saddle. Horses were historically ridden bareback. Now there are two types of saddles: the western and the English.

4. What green fruit is the main ingredient in making guacamole: apples or avocado?

Answer: Avocado. Guacamole, one of the best-loved dips in the world, is made with mashed avocados, onion, cilantro, lime juice, salt, hot green peppers, and sometimes tomatoes.

5. What type of footwear is worn by ice-hockey players: cleats or ice skates?

Answer: Ice skates. The earliest skates (circa 1000 BC) were made from the rib bones of an elk, reindeer, or other animal.

6. The company Ben & Jerry's is known for making which treat: cookies or ice cream?

Answer: Ice cream. Ben Cohen and Jerry Greenfield opened the very first Ben & Jerry's in an abandoned gas station in Burlington, Vermont, in 1978. The friends took a five-dollar correspondence course in ice cream making from the University of Pennsylvania.

7. Who serves drinks and snacks on airplanes: the pilot or flight attendants?

Answer: Flight attendants. The first stewardess was Ellen Church, in 1930. She was a nurse by trade and is responsible for creating the role of the stewardess.

8. Which is a type of cloud: lightning or cumulus?

Answer: Cumulus. Cumulus clouds are one of two types of low-lying clouds. The other is the stratus cloud. Cumulus clouds form vertically, and stratus clouds form horizontally.

9. What fast-food restaurant's mascot is Colonel Sanders: Burger King or Kentucky Fried Chicken?

Answer: Kentucky Fried Chicken. Harland Sanders, the creator of the popular chicken restaurant, started off working as a steamboat pilot, a railroad fireman, and a farmer. His famous southern chicken was first served in a roadside motel in Kentucky.

10. Which is a popular Disney character: Superman or Mickey Mouse?

Answer: Mickey Mouse. Mickey Mouse made his first appearance in the animated short film *Steamboat Willie*, which was released on November 18, 1928.

11. Which insect spins a web: a centipede or a spider?

Answer: Spider. Relative to its weight, a spider's silk is stronger and tougher than steel.

12. What item is used by artists to mix paint colors: a canvas or a paint palette?

Answer: Paint palette. **Fun fact:** The earliest colors found on cave paintings included red, yellow, brown, black, and white.

13. Which is the traditional main dish served for Thanksgiving dinner: beef or turkey?

Answer: Turkey. The traditional Thanksgiving dinner includes turkey, mashed potatoes, and cranberry sauce.

14. Which is a military rank: secretary or general?

Answer: General. The highest rank in the military is five-star general. Only nine Americans have held this rank.

15. Where would you go to buy fuel for vehicles: a grocery store or a gas station?

Answer: Gas station. In the late 20th century, alternative fuel mixtures were created from grains, potatoes, and other plant matter.

16. How many suits are in a deck of cards: two or four?

Answer: Four. Playing cards first appeared in Europe in 1370. The earliest cards were hand-printed and considered luxury goods for the rich.
