## Celebrities

1. Which actor starred in *The Philadelphia Story*: Clark Gable or Cary Grant?

**Answer:** Cary Grant. Cary Grant started performing as a juggler with a comedy troupe while honing his skills. He starred in Broadway shows before making his Paramount debut in 1932.

2. Which show was Andy Rooney known for: *Nightly News* or *60 Minutes*?

**Answer:** *60 Minutes*. Andy Rooney received a Lifetime Achievement Emmy Award for his work on the program. His appearances on *60 Minutes* spanned 32 years (1979–2011).

3. Which actress stars in the comedy TV show *The Golden Girls*: Katharine Hepburn or Betty White?

**Answer:** Betty White. In 2010, after a popular social media campaign, Betty White became the oldest host of *Saturday Night Live*. She won an Emmy Award for her performance.

4. Which actress did Prince Rainier III of Monaco marry: Ethel Merman or Grace Kelly?

**Answer:** Grace Kelly. Kelly starred in 11 movies prior to stepping away from show business to marry Prince Rainier III in 1956. Some of her works include *Dial M for Murder* and *To Catch a Thief*.

5. What actress is known as “America’s Mermaid”: Ethel Merman or Esther Williams?

**Answer:** Esther Williams. Williams was known as “America’s Mermaid” because of her ability to remain underwater for long periods of time.

6. Which style of dance did Gene Kelly perform in *Singin’ in the Rain*: salsa or tap dance?

**Answer:** Tap dance. Gene Kelly studied ballet, tap, and other styles of dance. His talents contributed to the evolution of movie musicals.

**Answer:** Antarctica. Antarctica is considered an icy desert. It is the fifth largest of the seven continents, with about 1,000 people living there in the winter and 10,000 people in the summer.
