Position Title: **Creative Expressions Facilitator**

Part-Time, Casual (6 hours per week)

The Alzheimer Society of Brant, Haldimand Norfolk, and Hamilton Halton (ASBHNHH) is looking for a “Creative Expressions Facilitator” to develop, deliver and evaluate our Creative Expressions Program which is based on the MoMA Alzheimer’s Project. This program will offer a weekly two-hour (2-hour) series of classes, in both Ancaster and Hamilton, for people in the early to mid-stage of dementia and their partner, friend, or family member.

Specialized Knowledge and Skill Requirements:

- Experience providing group programs for persons with dementia and their care partners
- Current knowledge on dementia
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work in a self-directed manner with a minimal amount of supervision
- Ability to work cooperatively, as a member of a team with staff, volunteers and other organizations
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Organizational and problem solving skills
- Clear criminal reference check for the vulnerable sector
- Ability to speak a second language is an asset

Educational and Experience Requirements:

- Diploma in Art Therapy preferred, or diploma/degree in Recreation Therapy with an arts background or health studies diploma/degree with an arts background
- Experience delivering and facilitating group programs for persons living with dementia
