

23. JACK CHANGE IT



PLAYERS

2-6

EASY

SETUP

Shuffle the deck and deal seven cards face down and one at a time to each player. The remaining cards form a draw deck in the middle of the play area. The top card is turned up and placed next to the deck, forming the discard pile.

PLAY

Beginning with the player sitting to the left of the dealer, they have to play a card from their hand that matches the top card in the discard pile, either by suit or rank. After they play one card, play moves to the next player to the left.

If a player does not have any eligible cards, they must draw one card from the draw pile and lose their turn.

Some cards have special effects in this game, and none of these cards can be used as a player's final card of the hand. If a player has one of these cards as their only remaining card, they must use their turn to draw a card and lose a turn.

Here are the special cards:

- When a two is played to the discard, the next player has to draw two cards from the deck. However, if they also have a two, they may play it and make the next player draw four cards.
- When an eight is played to the discard, the next player loses their turn.
- When a Jack is played to the discard, the player says, "Jack - change it to," and then names a suit for the next player to play.
- When a Queen is played in a game of three or more players, it reverses the gameplay order, so the player to the right plays next, instead of the left.
- When the Ace of Hearts is played to the discard, the next player must draw five cards. This card can be blocked by the 5 of Hearts, which is otherwise not considered a special card.
- If the deck is empty, keep the same top card but shuffle the rest of the discard pile to replenish it.

The game ends when one player gets rid of all of their cards!
