1. Which board game uses alphabet tiles to spell words: Monopoly or Scrabble?

Answer: Scrabble. The highest recorded score in a Scrabble tournament is 850.

2. Which type of plant comes back every year: annuals or perennials?

Answer: Perennials. Thousands of perennials come back year after year. Most have short bloom seasons ranging from a few days to weeks.

3. Which scale is used to measure the strength of the earthquakes: Newton or Richter scale?

Answer: Richter scale. Charles Richter developed the original Richter scale in the 1930s.

4. Where in space does a crew of seven astronauts live and work: a rocket or the International Space Station?

Answer: The International Space Station. The space station travels around Earth every 90 minutes.

5. Which famous roadway connects Chicago to Los Angeles: Route 1 or Route 66?

Answer: Route 66. The famous route was immensely popular after World War II but faded with the rise of the highway interstate system. It is 2,400 miles long.

6. Which type of nut is used in a popular pie: cashew or pecan?

Answer: Pecans. Pecans are the only tree nut grown naturally in North America.

7. Which spring sport features 162 games during the regular season: tennis or baseball?

Answer: Baseball. Cal Ripken Jr. appeared in all 162 regular season games for 10 seasons.

8. Which large suspension bridge is in San Francisco: the George Washington Bridge or the Golden Gate Bridge?

Answer: The Golden Gate Bridge. The bridge opened to traffic in May 1937.

9. According to the popular saying, “April showers bring May—”:

Answer: Flowers. June is considered the wettest month of the year in the United States.

10. Which famous playwright wrote *Romeo and Juliet*: Arthur Miller or William Shakespeare?

Answer: William Shakespeare. Shakespeare wrote over 37 plays and 150 poems.

11. Which spring sport is played by kicking a ball into a net with your foot: rugby or soccer?

Answer: Soccer. Soccer is the most popular team sport in the world. Every four years, countries compete for the World Cup title.

12. Which type of emergency vehicle takes sick or injured people to the hospital: a police car or an ambulance?

Answer: Ambulance. The earliest ambulance was a two-wheeled horse-drawn carriage in the early 1800s.

Answer: Curling iron. The first curling iron was patented in 1866.

14. Which type of shoes are worn in the rain: dress shoes or rain boots?

Answer: Rain boots. Rain boots are made from plastic or rubber to protect feet from water.

Answer: Strawberries. There are 20 different species of strawberries, and they are members of the rose family.
