- Ensures the completion of sign-in sheets at each class and forwards the information to the Team Lead
- Maintains a current knowledge of dementia, chronic diseases and exercise/fitness as it pertains to the health and well-being of individuals

Requirements:

- College degree/diploma in recreation or a health-related field is required
- Minimum two (2) to three (3) years experience in fitness instruction with persons living with dementia and older adults
- Must have valid standard CPR and first aid certification

- Vulnerable sector police check issued within 3 months of the hiring date.
