H.A.C Social Programs Volunteer Volunteer Position Description

Overview

The H.A.C Social Programs Volunteer plays a vital role in supporting the weekly social programs offered through the Alzheimer Society. These programs provide a welcoming and engaging environment for clients and caregivers to connect, socialize, and participate in meaningful activities. Volunteers help ensure each session runs smoothly and that all participants feel comfortable, supported, and included.

This program runs from 9:30 am to 1:00 pm on Thursdays.

Objective

To provide hands-on program support to staff and clients attending the weekly H.A.C. social programs by assisting with preparation, service, and engagement activities.

Roles in this Category Include (but are not limited to):

- Supporting the day-to-day needs of the weekly social program.
- Assisting with the preparation and delivery of meals and activities.
- Creating a positive, friendly atmosphere for participants.

Responsibilities & Tasks

- Assist with room setup and takedown, including moving tables, chairs, and materials (light lifting required).
- Support food preparation, cooking, and serving during program sessions.
- Maintain cleanliness in the kitchen area, including washing dishes and sanitizing surfaces.
- Engage with clients in a warm and respectful manner, encouraging social interaction and participation in activities.
- Support staff with program logistics as needed, following directions and safety guidelines.

Qualities and Skills

- Physically able to perform light lifting and room setup tasks.
- Comfortable with safe food handling practices.
- Strong teamwork, communication, and active listening skills.
- Friendly, patient, and respectful in interactions with clients, staff, and volunteers.
- Experience or familiarity with individuals living with dementia or other diverse populations is an asset.

- Maintain confidentiality at all times; only share client information with Alzheimer Society staff as required.
- Do not provide medical advice, treatment recommendations, or referrals.
- Do not share personal contact information with clients or caregivers.

Commitment

- Approximately 2–4 hours per week for a minimum of 6 months, or
- Approximately 5 hours per month for a minimum of 6 months, depending on the program schedule.

Preliminary Screening Requirements

- Completed volunteer application
- Two references
- Police record check / vulnerable sector screening
- Signed Confidentiality Agreement
- Signed Conflict of Interest Agreement

This volunteer position reports directly to a designated Alzheimer Society staff member who provides guidance, supervision, and ongoing feedback to ensure a positive and meaningful volunteer experience.
