

Discard It Dice and Card Game

This easy game can be played by small or large groups.

Object of the game:

The object of the game is to be the first person to discard all of their cards.

Setup:

- Standard deck of playing cards with the jokers removed. Use one deck for 2–7 players; two decks for 7–14 players; and three decks for more than 14 players.
- Two dice
- Dice cup for rolling the dice

Card values:

Ace = 1
Jack = 11
Queen = 12
All other cards are face value.



Playing the game:

1. Deal 7 cards to each player. Players hold the cards in their hand so the other players cannot see them.
2. Players discard all the kings in their hand, plus one other card. Only one extra card can be discarded no matter how many kings are discarded. Discarded cards are placed faceup.
3. The player to the dealer's left rolls the dice. The player then calls out the numbers on the individual dice **or** the total combined number on the dice. For example, if the player rolls a 5 and a 1, they can call out "6" or "5 and 1." (Note: It is in the player's best interest to choose the number[s] that benefits them.) All the players with the corresponding cards can discard them.
4. Play continues until one player has discarded all of his or her cards. They win.
